

Description

CaM-kinase II (CAMK2) is a prominent kinase in the central nervous system that may function in long-term potentiation and neurotransmitter release. Member of the NMDAR signaling complex in excitatory synapses it may regulate NMDAR-dependent potentiation of the AMPAR and synaptic plasticity (By similarity). Phosphorylates transcription factor FOXO3 on 'Ser-298'. Activates FOXO3 transcriptional activity (By similarity). [UniProt]

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the CAMK2A antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

A recombinant human protein corresponding to amino acids L392-R457 was used as the immunogen for the CAMK2A antibody.

Storage

After reconstitution, the CAMK2A antibody can be stored for up to one month at 4oC. For long-term, aliquot and store at -20oC. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
