



Description

Sialophorin (leukosialin) is a major sialoglycoprotein on the surface of human T lymphocytes, monocytes, granulocytes, and some B lymphocytes, which appears to be important for immune function and may be part of a physiologic ligand-receptor complex involved in T-cell activation.

Application Notes

Titration of the CD43 antibody may be required due to differences in protocols and secondary/substrate sensitivity.

Immunogen

A portion of amino acids 32-60 from the human protein was used as the immunogen for this CD43 antibody.

Storage

Aliquot the CD43 antibody and store frozen at -20oC or colder. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
