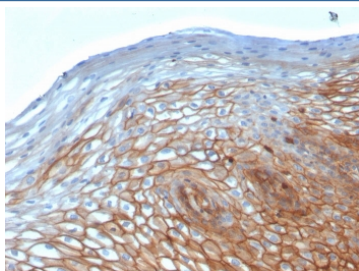

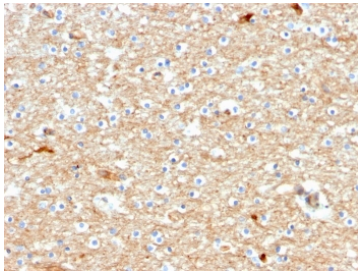

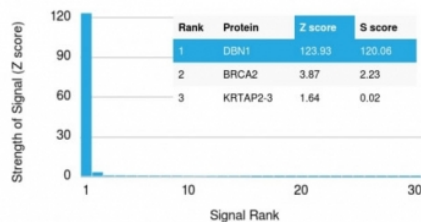

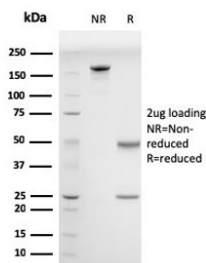

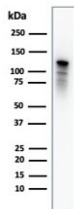
Human Protein Microarray Specificity Validation



Analysis of HuProt(TM) microarray containing more than 19,000 full-length human proteins using Drebrin antibody (clone DBN1/2880). These results demonstrate the foremost specificity of the DBN1/2880 mAb. Z- and S- score: The Z-score represents the strength of a signal that an antibody (in combination with a fluorescently-tagged anti-IgG secondary Ab) produces when binding to a particular protein on the HuProt(TM) array. Z-scores are described in units of standard deviations (SD) above the mean value of all signals generated on that array. If the targets on the HuProt(TM) are arranged in descending order of the Z-score, the S-score is the difference (also in units of SD) between the Z-scores. The S-score therefore represents the relative target specificity of an Ab to its intended target.

Description

Drebrins (developmentally regulated brain proteins) are cytoplasmic proteins that bind F-actin in the brain and are involved in cell migration, extension of neuronal processes and plasticity of dendrites. There are three isoforms: two embryonic types (E1 and E2); and an adult type (A), generated by alternative RNA splicing from a single Drebrin gene. Drebrins are expressed mainly in brain neurons but are also found in skeletal muscle, heart, placenta, pancreas and kidney. Drebrin has been designated as a marker of the dendritic spine. Decreases in Drebrin levels in the brain have been associated with Alzheimer's disease and Down syndrome.

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the Drebrin 1 antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

A recombinant human partial protein (amino acids 150-281) was used as the immunogen for the Drebrin antibody.

Storage

Store the Drebrin 1 antibody at 2-8oC (with azide) or aliquot and store at -20oC or colder (without azide).
