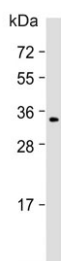

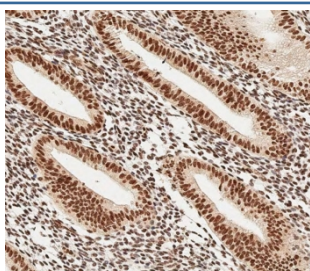

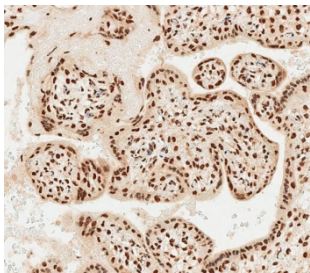

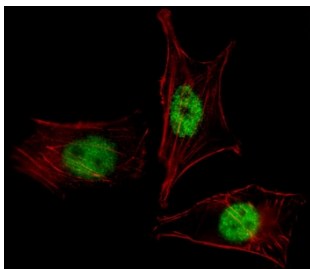
Western blot testing of human MCF7 cell lysate with MOX-2 antibody. Predicted molecular weight ~34 kDa.

Description

The MEOX2 gene encodes a member of a subfamily of non-clustered, diverged, antennapedia-like homeobox-containing genes. The encoded protein may play a role in the regulation of vertebrate limb myogenesis. Mutations in the related mouse protein may be associated with craniofacial and/or skeletal abnormalities, in addition to neurovascular dysfunction observed in Alzheimer's disease.

Application Notes

The stated application concentrations are suggested starting points. Titration of the MOX-2 antibody may be required due to differences in protocols and secondary/substrate sensitivity.

Immunogen

A portion of amino acids 164-192 from the human protein was used as the immunogen for the MOX-2 antibody.

Storage

Aliquot the MOX-2 antibody and store frozen at -20oC or colder. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
