







ELISA of human immunoglobulins shows the recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody reacts to the kappa light chain of human immunoglobulins. No cross reactivity with the lambda light chain, mouse IgG, rat IgG, or goat IgG.



ELISA Titration: the plate was coated with different amounts of human IgG4κ. A serial dilution of the recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody was used as the primary and an alkaline phosphatase conjugated anti-rabbit IgG as the secondary.



IHC testing of FFPE human tonsil tissue with recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody. A pH6 Citrate buffer or pH9 Tris/EDTA buffer HIER step is recommended for testing of FFPE tissue sections.

# **Description**

This recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody reacts to the kappa light chain of human immunoglobulins. No cross reactivity with the lambda light chain, mouse IgG, rat IgG, or goat IgG.

#### **Application Notes**

The stated application concentrations are suggested starting points. Titration of the recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody may be required due to differences in protocols and secondary/substrate sensitivity.

#### **Immunogen**

Human IgG was used as the immunogen for this recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody.

### **Storage**

Store the recombinant Human Kappa Light Chain antibody at -20oC.
