## **Description**

Recognizes a 67kDa glycoprotein, which is identified as CD33. It is a transmembrane protein of the sialic acid-binding immunoglobulin-like lectin (Siglec) family. It belongs to the immunoreceptor tyrosine-based inhibitory motif (ITIM)-containing molecules able of recruiting protein tyrosine phosphatases SHP-1 and SHP-2 to signal assemblies;

these ITIMs are also used for ubiquitin-mediated removal of the receptor from the cell surface. CD33 is expressed on cells of myelomonocytic lineage, binds sialic acid residues in N- and O-glycans on cell surfaces, and is a therapeutic target for acute myeloid leukemia. CD33 is expressed on myeloid progenitors, monocytes, granulocytes, dendritic cells and mast cells. It is absent on platelets, lymphocytes, erythrocytes and hematopoietic stem cells.

### **Application Notes**

Optimal dilution of the recombinant SIGLEC3 antibody should be determined by the researcher.

#### **Immunogen**

A portion of amino acids 100-300 from human CD33 protein was used as the immunogen for the recombinant SIGLEC3 antibody.

#### **Storage**

Aliquot the recombinant SIGLEC3 antibody and store frozen at -20oC or colder. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
