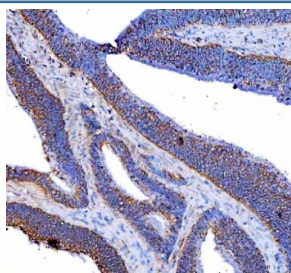

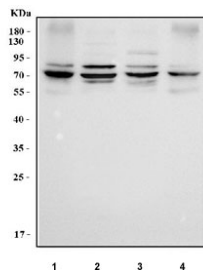

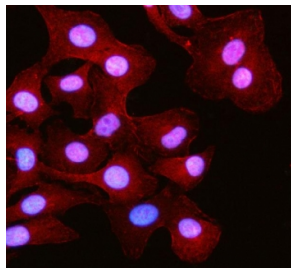

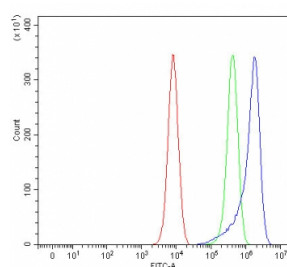

Description

Radial spoke head protein 3 homolog (RSPH3), also known as radial spoke head-like protein 2 (RSHL2), is a protein that in humans is encoded by the RSPH3 gene. The protein encoded by this gene acts as a protein kinase A anchoring protein. Mutations in this gene cause primary ciliary dyskinesia; a disorder characterized by defects of the axoneme in motile cilia and sperm flagella. The homolog of this gene was first identified in the blue-green algae *Chlamydomonas* as encoding a radial spoke protein that formed a structural component of motile cilia and flagella. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms.

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the RSPH3 antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

An E.coli-derived human recombinant protein (Q31-H473) was used as the immunogen for the RSPH3 antibody.

Storage

After reconstitution, the RSPH3 antibody can be stored for up to one month at 4°C. For long-term, aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
