Description

KIAA0644, also known as TRIL or TLR4 interactor with leucine rich repeats, is a protein that in humans is encoded by the KIAA0644 gene. TRIL is a component of the TLR4 complex and is induced in a number of cell types by lipopolysaccharide (LPS).

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the TRIL antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

E. coli-derived recombinant human protein (amino acids V26-Q696) was used as the immunogen for the TRIL antibody. **Storage** After reconstitution, the TRIL antibody can be stored for up to one month at 4oC. For long-term, aliquot and store at -20oC. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
